AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC VOTE COUNTING DEVICES
AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 530


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HANCEVILLE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

- Section One:** Chapter 7 of Title 17 of the Alabama Code of 1975, and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto by the Alabama Electronic Voting Committee, provide for the use of Electronic Vote Counting Systems.
- Section Two:** Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama 1975 provides that a municipality may, in its discretion, authorize, adopt, and direct the use of electronic vote counting systems for use in all elections held in such municipality.
- Section Three:** For all elections held subsequent to the passage of this ordinance, the use of DS200 and ExpressVote Counting Devices, which comply with Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto, is authorized for the reporting, counting, and tabulating of any and all election results.
- Section Four:** Ordinance No. 530 adopted on the 23rd day of June 2008, Establishing The Use of Electronic Vote Counting Devices is hereby repealed.
- Section Five:** The Mayor of the City of Hanceville shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State as provided in Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama 1975.
